Year 5 have had another exciting week learning about Africa!

In writing the pupils have continued developing their skills in order to write a narrative story inspired by The Lion King. Using a thesaurus, the children have begun up levelling their vocabulary to ensure it they are avoiding boring words and making their writing exciting. Pupils have also been working on their sentence starters again; to make sure the reader remains engaged thought their story. We can't wait to read their finished stories next week.

In maths the children have been working hard at mastering their knowledge on decimals. At the start of the week they were adding various numbers working up towards subtracting by the end of the week. They have become experts on the topic!

In French this week the children have been learning how to spell and pronounce different pets that people may have. They discovered that un chien is a dog and une souris is a mouse. The pupils of Year 5 spent time learning which of the animals took the masculine or the feminine form.
