Year 5 have had another successful week.

**Maths** - Year 5 were consolidating their learning this week and the amount they have absorbed over the last few weeks was extremely evident by how well they answered their problem-solving questions.

**Reading** - Year 5 have continued to read the class novel 'Cosmic' they have reached the first major dilemma of the book, that being who will Liam find to pretend to be his daughter. Year 5 have worked really hard on forming reasonable predictions by using evidence from the text.

**Writing** - Year 5 have created persuasive pieces of writing, explore why someone should become an astronaut. We considered the dangers and benefits of space travel and if the reward is worth the risk.

**History** - The pupils were able to identify and organise key dates of space exploration/. They created their own time line and considered which dates were most significant for humanity.

**Science** - Pupils looked at and considered the Geocentric and Heliocentric models of the universe, we discussed the influence of famous physicians such as Galileo and Copernicus.
