Making Torches!

Year 4 have had yet another exciting week!

This week, we delved into the fascinating geography of India. The children learned about the majestic Himalayas, the vast Thar Desert, and the sacred River Ganges. They also explored significant human-made landmarks such as the iconic Taj Mahal and the bustling cities of Mumbai. To deepen their understanding, the students used maps to locate these features and label them with a key.

In maths, time-telling was a key focus this week. The children practiced reading both analogue and digital clocks, mastering time to the hour, half-hour, quarter-hour, and in 5-minute increments. They also learned about AM and PM and next week will move onto reading a 24-hour clock.

We started our design technology project this week which was particularly exciting – the children have begun making torches! Using simple materials like toilet rolls, paint and clear plastic pots, the children have made extremely unique designs. They can't wait to construct their circuits in order for them to work.

In writing this week, the children finished their action-packed jungle stories. We loved reading them!
