Marvellous Mathematicians!

In Maths the children completed their end of unit test on fractions and have now moved onto decimals. They have become experts at counting up in tenths and plotting different decimals onto a numberline.

In Writing this week, Year 4 have moved onto their writing to persuade unit. They have spent time learning the different key features used in a persuasive text including looking closely at using emotive language. The children worked hard at up levelling words such as sad and happy to make the reader feel a stronger emotion.

In History this week, the children listened and read different accounts recorded of the BP oil spill in 2010. The children compared the different accounts and thought about why people, such as the communities affected and Barack Obama had different views on the disaster.

In computing this half term, the children have been learning about podcasts. Year 4 have had lots of fun recording themselves speaking about endangered animals and have even moved onto editing their recordings.

In Geography the children presented their interesting findings from their 'Litter pick'. They created neat bar graphs of their class data which showed the amount of each material they found.
