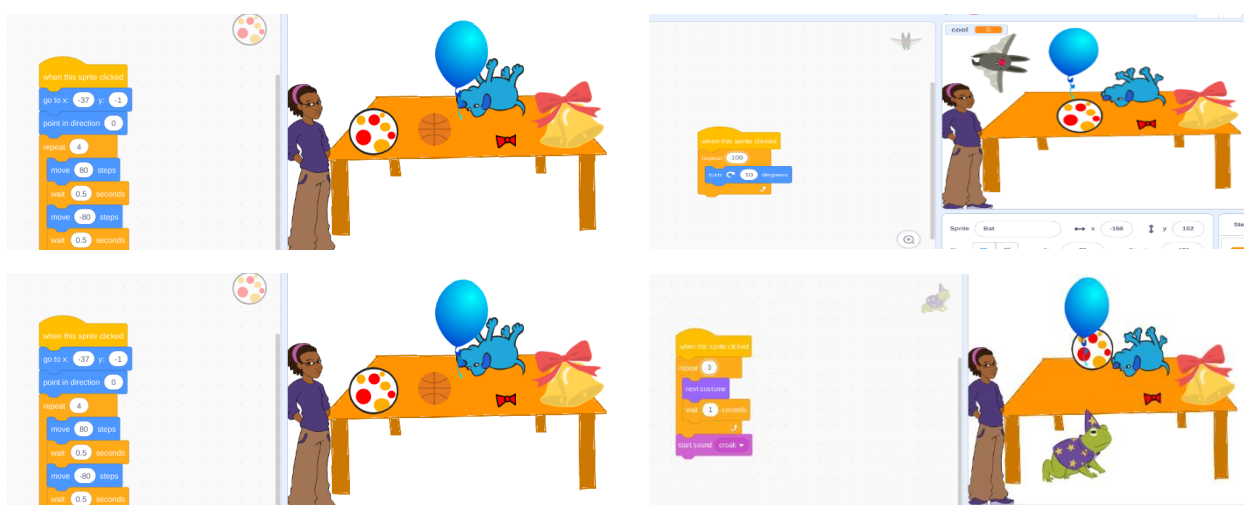


Year 4 Blog - Week Commencing 23.01.23: Scratch Fun!
