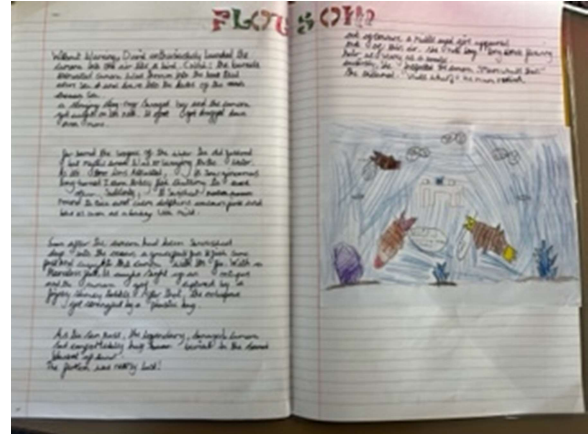
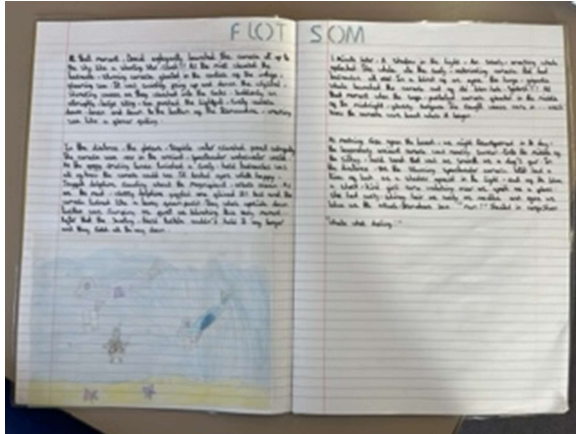
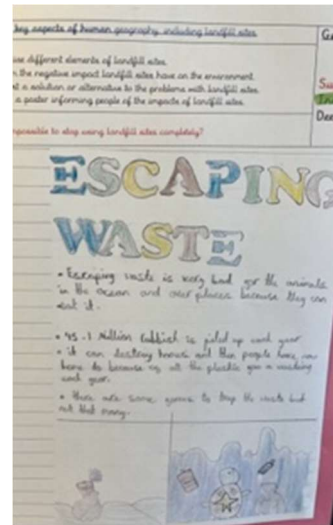
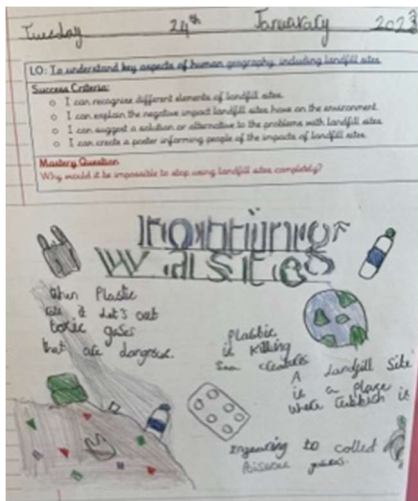


Week Commencing 23.01.23: Escaping Waste
