

Year 6 blog – week commencing 17th June 2024

Charles Darwin, blues music and a police positive action roadshow!

It has been another busy week in year 6. We started the week by attending via zoom, the police positive action roadshow, where the children learnt about county lines, crime in the community, mental health awareness, value versus violence and careers. The children learnt a lot during this session, especially about how to support ourselves and other people with mental health.

In music, we completed our second lesson on blues music from the early 1900s. The slow pace of the music enabled the children to understand different tempos.

We finished our learning on Charles Darwin in geography and science, the children were able to understand and explain the theory behind natural selection and how species evolve based on their habitats. We also looked in detail at Charles Darwin's journey on the beagle, looking at his most significant findings and how they changed the theories of species, evolution and inheritance.

The children have also been rehearsing for our production, where they are learning both their lines and the songs and it is beginning to look and sound amazing! Please can all children practice the songs and their lines by Monday without their scripts.
