### Osamu Tezuka, Nutrition and Lewis Capaldi!

This week in year 6, we have been working on a number of different topics, including:

Writing a biography about Osamu Tezuka, he is a famous manga and anime artist in Japan. The children enjoyed writing about his life and achievements; using online research to aid their writing. A number of children said they wanted to read/watch 'Astro Boy' by him.

In Science this week we focused on nutrition and why water is good for our bodies. We also discovered that our liver and kidneys are key organs for processing vitamins, minerals and fluid in our body. The children were inquisitive to know if we could live with only one kidney and why we could – this lesson made for fantastic discussion!

In RE, we were discussing the design argument – looking at the different arguments as to whether this could possibly be correct. The design argument is a religious argument that the world has a designer and we as humans and the world were designed by a religious god.
