### Mouldy bread experiment, an abandoned theme park and a celebration assembly.

We have had a very busy week in year 6 this week!

We started the week with assessments, the children worked extremely hard throughout and we are seeing the progress they have made this term!

In writing, the children learnt about an abandoned theme park in Japan called 'Dreamland', we then planned our narrative, deciding which grammar we were including that we had learnt, as well as how our stories would be laid out and considering the five senses to set the scene. In Science, we looked at microorganisms, the good and the bad. How we can look after ourselves to prevent bad microorganisms, as well as how microorganisms are used in antibiotics to make us better. We then planned our mould experiments, deciding on dependant and controlled variables to undergo a fair experiment. The children are thoroughly looking forward to seeing how much mould grows over the next few days.
