Drama workshop part two, Lego spike and classifying animals.

Part Two of the drama workshop with The King School was a success again, the second group thoroughly enjoyed learning new drama skills and working together to act out different scenes of plays with a narrator!

In writing, the children have been writing a diary entry based on our topic book Kensuke's Kingdom. The children included apostrophes for omission and possession, as well as relative clauses to add to their entry. The children have fantastic imaginations for writing and the year 6 team thoroughly enjoyed reading them.

In science, we looked at similarities and differences of animals, exploring how animals are classified when they have similar features. The children researched their animals to understand why they have been classified by their differences as opposed to their similarities.

We continued our Lego Spike robot building in year 6, exploring ways of using different pieces of Lego to make our robots, making sure the changes we make are still viable with different pieces.
