All of Year 6 have written their letters from on board the RMS Titanic as if they had either a first class, second class or third-class ticket. We explored what entitlements you got onboard the Titanic, what the conditions were like and expressed this in the form of a letter home. The children really enjoyed writing their letter including great detail and altering the appearance of their finished piece giving it an old-fashioned look.

The children have continued to read Noor Inayat Khan and learnt more about what life was like undercover in France and behind enemy lines. We will be looking into Noor Inayat Khan in greater detail next week and writing a biography in their writing lessons.

In writing this week the children have been taking the role of a journalist and writing their newspaper reports during The Blitz using great descriptive language to describe the tragic and catastrophic events London faced during the bombings.

In science this week we have been exploring how light travels in straight lines, sources and reflectors of light. The children conducted an investigation where they explored the incident and the reflective rays presented and how this helps us to see.

In Maths across year 6 we have covered fractions using the four operations the children have shown great resilience and challenged themselves. Children have also applied themselves tremendously to complete questions at a great pace showing growth mindset.
