

The Blitz and Climate Emergency!

This week was another busy week for Year 6 starting to look at World War 2 in greater detail.

In Maths the children have continued their hard work on adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators, including mixed numbers and multi-step problems. The children are completing these problems whilst also using the correct mathematical vocabulary which is really good to see and embedding that learning!

In Writing this week the children have started their Blitz narrative which has seen the children immerse themselves in what life would have been like during the air raids in World War 2. We have watched videos and had in class discussions to help us with our narrative planning. The children have produced some wonderful setting descriptions reflecting what it was like during the Blitz.

Year 6 have continued with their reading of Noor Inayat Khan, this has been a gripping book from start to finish and has provided an in depth perspective on war. We have also looked at other extracts from World War 2 which have inspired children whilst writing their own Blitz narrative. We have encouraged the children to continue reading any other World War 2 literature to help them further with their topic writing.

In Geography the children have been exploring poverty across the world and how climate change can directly affect this. The children were set the task of creating posters on what we can do personally to help with climate change using emotive language, repetition and rhetorical questions.
