

Year 6 Blog – Week Commencing 26.06.2023: Transition days, rehearsals, running, running and more running!

This has been a very exciting week for the majority of our Year 6 pupils as they experienced two transition days at their new secondary schools. It has been wonderful to hear all their stories and excitement when they returned to tell us all about their experience.

In PE this week, Year 6 took part in their athletic try outs in preparation for next Thursday's Sports Day. The children demonstrated their team work and determination during tug of war and the relay race. They then showed their perseverance in the long-distance race of two laps around our school fields. Following this, they then completed a 400m sprint. The children are really excited for their Sports Day morning which is next Thursday.

The children who did not attend transition days worked really hard - designing programmes and advertising posters for our end of year production of 'The Lion King'. They also used scratch to utilise their coding skills to produce a Lion King based scene, the coding allowed them to make their characters do different actions and sequences.

The whole year group have been working hard rehearsing, making props, mastering the technical support. The last few days have shown how much hard work the children are putting into their end of year production, the cues are smoother, singing is louder and has improved as the children learn all of their words. The creative design team have worked tirelessly this week, ensuring props are created and ready to be used in rehearsals.
