This week, Year 6 have been working hard in writing lessons; producing a fantastic diary entry, writing as Harry Potter walking down Diagon Alley. Pupils have used descriptive devices, parenthesis and contracted words. In maths, we have started to learn about percentages of amounts and have begun converting fractions into percentages and vice versa.
