Marvellous Mayans!

The Year 3s had a super interesting last week of half term. The children have been learning lots of fascinating information about the Ancient Mayan civilization, and on Monday, they were treated to a Mayan Workshop, where they got to meet a 'real life' Mayan. In this workshop they learnt about the Mayan's beliefs on the creation story, and the children also participated in Mayan dramatizations.

Later in the week, the Year 3s took part in the third installment of the 'My Future Leaders' program. They were introduced to careers in the fashion industry, and got to meet a hat maker (a milliner), a jeweler designer and a specialist who does vehicle wrapping.

Lastly, in Science, the learners have been delving into lots of interesting aspects of the topic 'Light'. This included understanding the meaning of key terminology such as transparent, opaque and translucent, and well as learning about how shadows are formed. This week's lesson focused on recognizing that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes.
