Paddington's adventures around London

This week, Year 3 have been enjoying learning about how fossils are made in science. They watched a video that showed how fossils were made over thousands of years and then completed a storyboard to show this. After, they had a go at sketching an animal on one side and then on the other once it had gone through the fossilization process thousands of years later.

In maths, the children have been focusing on multiplication and division. They have been learning about how arrays can support their learning of their times tables and using sharing and grouping to divide numbers.

In English, the children have been continuing their unit on Paddington's adventures. They have begun writing their own stories based on Paddington's journey around London, trying to include subordinating conjunctions and speech punctuation.
