

Year 3 Blog – Week Commencing 25.09.2023: Exploring the rainy, rumbling rainforest

This week, Year 3 have enjoyed exploring more about the rainforest and using the 5 senses to create vivid descriptions about it. They have enjoyed creating expanded noun phrases, similes, adjectives and alliteration to describe a waterfall scene in a rainforest. Below are some examples.

In science, the children have been discovering how water is transported through plants and created an experiment to show how water can travel upwards. They created some predictions about what they thought would happen and then watched and discussed what they could see.

In history, they began exploring the Ancient Greeks and have been looking at different artefacts to discuss what they can see going on and what this tells us about life in Ancient Greece.
