This week, Year 3 have been enjoying their explorer's topic by beginning to explore new book for this term 'Miranda the Explorer'. In science this week, the children have set up their own experiment to find out what requirement plants need the most by planting runner bean seeds in pots in different places around the classroom. They have been observing them throughout the week.
