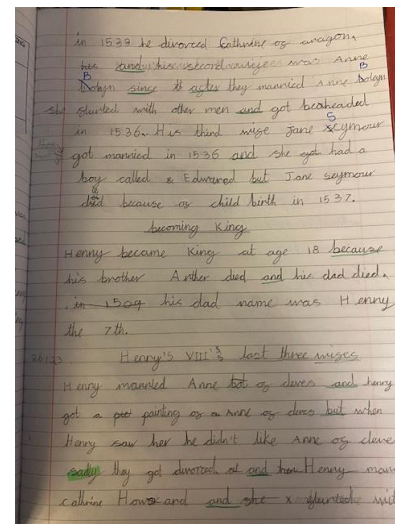
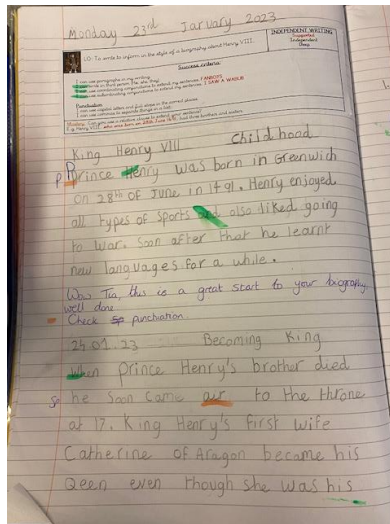
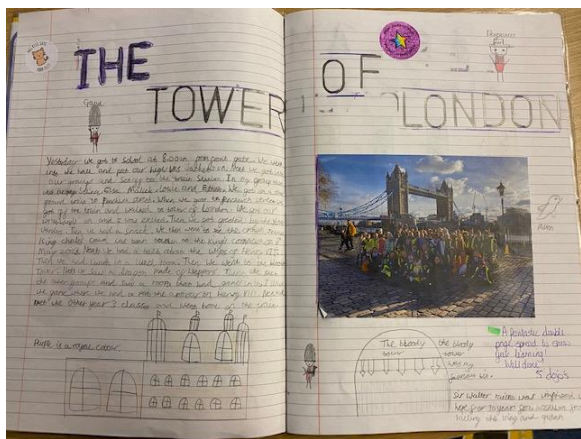


Year 3 Blog - Week Commencing 23.01.23: Horrible Henry VIII
