- What are the SATs? SATs stands for Standard Assessment Test and is the national standard by which children's progress and development is assessed by our government. It lays a foundation for your child's future education at Secondary level and thus it is a critical component in your child's education.
- Year 6 is a tough year where much pressure rests on the shoulders of your children. It is our job to guide them through and support them on their journey towards this milestone in their education. That means extra tutoring groups where necessary, mock examinations to gauge their progress and a gradual revision of all they have learned from Year 3 until the present. We want to alleviate all their worries and ensure they enjoy this year and achieve their best in Year 6.
- Homework: please can you ensure that your child completes the homework and support as needed from home. Please contact the class teacher if you need any support with this. Please see the following page for homework details.

## Homework Expectations

**Reading:** children are expected to read for at least twenty minutes, five times a week and complete their reading record after reading with a short comment. To receive 5 dojos at the end of each week, a parent or carer needs to sign to the right

on their reading record to confirm they have read at home. Reading can bring so much joy to children and is their key to the rest of the curriculum and their future. This is why we require support from home to nurture a passion for books and reading. Encouraging reading is of utmost importance in a child's education. **Times Table Rockstars:** – times tables are a priority and can be improved with repetition. To ensure a successful Year 6, times tables must be completed at least three times a week. Pupil log ins are in the back of their yellow Reading Record diary.

**Spellings:** Spellings will be given out and tested weekly on a Friday. Some pupils will have additional common exception words to practice. The list of common exception words for Year 5 and 6 is part of the National Curriculum and can be easily found online. Please support their development of spelling through continuing to learn these at home.

**Curriculum Homework:** teachers will be setting reading and research tasks for pupils on an online platform called 'Curriculum Visions' which you can log in from home. This is a fantastic website to help pupils learn more about a range of topics. In addition to the tasks their teachers direct them to read via Google Classroom, pupils can freely search for other topics they are interested in from home, even if we are not studying them in school. The platform also has a selection of interesting videos. Log in details are:
