Monday 12th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 13th May	English reading paper
Wednesday 14th May	Mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
Thursday 15th May	Mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)
